Hold On To Your Faith Confession

Always say what God says about you, about your situations, about your life and about your future.

The Lord Jesus taught us that faith is release through words
Mark 11:22-23

Faith must make its confession
Romans 10:6-10
God's Word is in our heart to believe it.
God's Word is in our mouth to confess it.
Confession is saying what you believe.

God's power is released when we speak God's Word in faith.
Hebrews 4:12 God's Word is full of God's power
Hebrews 1:3 The Lord upholds all things by His powerful Word
Hebrews 11:3 Everything in the natural was formed and shaped by the Word. So the Word has power over everything in the natural.

Now, God is teaching us in Romans 10:8-10 that His Word is to be in our heart and in our mouth, to believe it and speak it. For what purpose? So that the power in that Word is now released in our lives

There is power in the spoken Word to shape and regulate your world.

Jesus is the High Priest of our Confession

Hebrews 3:1

We are to hold on to what we believe, walk by, live by and confess.

We also use the power of the spoken Word as we minister to people, overcome adverse situations in life and deal with demonic powers



When ministering to people - speak God's Word over them. Declare and decree God's blessings, power, plans and purposes over their lives.
